What is Child's Play "CDPHE Spec." system?

Child's Play has designed a surfacing system that provides maximum protection for children and at the same time maximizes the amount of recycled tires used for play surfaces. The surface is a 3 layer system that can be installed over existing sand or pea gravel surfaces eliminating the cost of removals and construction of stone bases.

What it means to school boards cities and rural communities

The Waste Tire Fund program was established to encourage recycling of Colorado waste tire and is administered by way of CDPHE's Incentive Program. **The program will fund up to 100% of the cost of a product that is manufactured using Colorado Waste Tire.** It will only fund the cost of the manufactured products; such things as base construction, removals, etc. are not funded by the program. All communities can now afford to upgrade their play surfaces or build new playgrounds in their communities.

The average cost to the end user is now in the range of **\$1.00/ft²** – a cost that cannot be matched anywhere for an all-weather, CPSC, ADA compliant surface that will last for many years to come!



Since 1999 the State of Colorado has funded over 200 grants and awarded in excess of \$5,000,000!
